

Technical Information – Handling Pressure Cylinders

The fuel gas and test gas bottles sold by Hermann Sewerin GmbH are pressure cylinders, which are classified as dangerous goods.

For that reason transport is handled by a shipping company that is authorised to transport dangerous goods.

A portion of the additional costs involved is billed by us separately. These additional shipping costs are incurred only once per delivery of dangerous goods.

Procedure for cylinder refills

Please be aware that Hermann Sewerin GmbH only accepts gas bottles that were originally purchased from us.

You will not get the same bottle back that you sent to us. To speed up the delivery process, we use the commonest bottle types. This has the added advantage that you always receive a bottle with a valid TÜV inspection.

If you would like to have your gas bottle refilled, please proceed as follows:

- The bottle must be fitted with a valve cover and valve guard. Please return the bottle via a shipping company (dangerous goods!). A safety data sheet is supplied with all our gas bottles. - Please attach your new order to the empty bottle. This will help us to process your order more quickly.
- You will generally receive a gas bottle filled with the gas you requested within a week. However, for rare or technically difficult gases (e.g. odorants, ammonia), delivery may take several weeks.
